4- Our Firm Internal Quality Control System

A key component of the network is the provision of high-quality services that comply with standards and regulations wherever a client requires assistance.

When undertaking audit and assurance work the professional accountant has a responsibility to act in the public interest. Acting in the public interest means that delivering consistent quality engagements that are in compliance with the required standards and applicable law and regulation comes before the commercial interests of the firm.

Therefore, our Cambodia office's documents and expectations include that firms will comply with International Quality Management (previously Control) Standards in the work they perform. This is intended to provide assurance that the services they provide to all clients, both local and referred by other network firms, are of appropriate quality.

The first year complied with International Standard on Quality Control 1 (ISQM 1).

We consider that good governance, commitment to quality, the application of ethical requirements and robust risk management procedures are critical to our success. We consider that the internal quality control system is functioning at a suitable level of effectiveness for a firm of our size and are committed to continuing improvement as a firm.

Quality Management Roles and Responsibilities within the firm

Responsibility for audit quality committee within the firm for the year ended 31 December 2023 rested primarily with the following individuals:

- 1-Ms. Haing Sivtieng, Managing Director
- 2-Mr. Yim Ravin, Technical Support and Quality Review Manager
- 3- Mr. Keat Heng, Audit Partner
- 4- Mr. Sim Hoychhoung, Audit Partner

Day to day responsibility for audit quality control rests with the Quality Committee, the Quality Review Manager and Audit partner, all of whom are considered to have sufficient and appropriate experience, ability and authority to perform their roles. They are supported by the firm's Technical Team, which has been further expanded during the year. We believe that our internal quality control system is operating effectively.

5- Our Firm Monitoring Audit Performance Internal monitoring

Quality control is conducted by our Quality Review Committee (RC). The audit file review system aims to ensure that the work of audit is subject to review every 2 years. In addition, similar reviews of non-audit work are undertaken. This internal review system helps ensure that standards are met and that any issues identified can be dealt with at an early stage. The last full audit file review was undertaken for the calendar year ended 31 December 2023. The review for 2023 will conduct in October 2024.

The reviews focus on compliance with relevant professional standards and our internal policies and procedures, as well as on the quality of the work performed. The reviews are risk focused and performed by partners and people who are independent of the office at which the RC is based and the client. An internally developed checklist is used to perform and document the reviews and each peer review team includes a member of the Review Team to ensure that any necessary consultation can take place (for instance on whether a relevant requirement has been complied with or whether an accounting treatment has been correctly applied). In addition, other specialist reviewers are used where necessary, for instance where IFRS or charity expertise is required.

The Review Committee also provides training to all reviewers on the objective and conduct of the reviews.

The results of these reviews are considered by the RC. The RC will form a judgement as to the quality of each file reviewed and, where necessary, follow up with the relevant partners to ensure that any shortcomings are addressed.

All files are graded based on a modified 'traffic light' system. The person who conducted the peer review makes an initial recommendation of the grade which is then considered by a subcommittee of the Review Committee. The Reviewer then makes a recommendation to the RC of the grade to be awarded.

The grades are as follows:

Green: a good file with no issues of importance.

Yellow: the file quality is acceptable, with some limited improvements required. Red: the file quality is unsatisfactory with significant improvement required

External monitoring

As a member of the Kreston Global network, the firm is subject to periodic quality reviews which are performed by an experienced reviewer in our network firm in the region which instructed by the Global Quality Committee.

As an auditor of Public Interest Entities, our firm is also subject to external monitoring by Accounting & Audit Regulator (ACAR). The firm's last full visit took place in 2023 by Accounting & Audit Regulator and Kreston Global.

6. Our Firm Public Interest Entity Audit Clients

Our firm granted financial institution audit license from National Bank of Cambodia in 2022. Now we audit one Commercial Bank and several Micro Finance Institutions as PIE.



7- Our Firm Independence Policies and Practices

All our partners and people are required to complete annual declarations of their independence. Any circumstances which may have an effect on their independence, or any actual or potential conflict of interest are required to be alerted to the engagement audit partner who will inform the managing director of any issues potentially impacting audit independence. In the event of any such circumstances an appropriate action plan is formulated in consultation with the Managing Director or Global quality manager.

An additional review of audit work by an engagement quality control reviewer (EQCR) is mandatory for all PIE and other listed clients and is also required for certain other clients, for instance very large private companies and high profile charities.

Rotation of key audit partners and staff is conducted in accordance with the requirements of the Ethical Standard, including rotation of audit engagement partners on listed company audits every five years and EQCRs every seven years.

As a member of the Kreston Global network, we also update the network's database with the details of our public interest entity and listed audit clients. Additional conflict checks are also undertaken where required by email, across the worldwide network, coordinated by Kreston's team.

8- Our People Development

All of our people, including audit engagement team, internal reviewer, are expected to consider their development needs carefully and commit to undertaking an appropriate level of training to obtain or maintain the level of expertise they need. T
